



## **Tillsonburg Minor Hockey Inc. Max Partlo Memorial U18 LL Tournament**

### TOURNAMENT INFORMATION & RULES

All teams guaranteed a minimum 3 games. Top team from each pool move on from Round Robin play to play for example, winner from Pool A will play winner from Pool B. Refer to Points and Rankings below in regards to seed rankings for division winners. Semi Finals and Finals to be played on Sunday.

1. All OMHA Rules and Regulations apply.
2. The Tournament Convenors reserve the right to make decisions regarding the interpretation of the Rules and Regulations, and as such, all decisions will be final.
3. All referee calls are final.
4. Home teams wear light colored jerseys and visitor teams wear dark jerseys
5. There will be a 3 minute warm-up before each game.
6. Teams must be dressed and ready to play 15 minutes before each game if we are running ahead game will start max 15 min early.
7. No players are to be on the ice without a referee present, do not enter the ice until the Zamboni is off the ice and the doors are closed, this includes the bench staff. The arena has a strict policy to this.
8. Game Format:
  - a. Round Robin Games:
    - i. 10-10-12 stop time
  - b. Elimination Games (Semi-Finals and Finals): 10-10-15 minute periods, stop time.
9. Ice will be cleaned following each game.

### Time-Outs

1. Teams are allowed one 30 second time-out per game during regulation time in Semi-Finals and Finals games only.
2. No time-outs allowed during overtime, or in Round Robin play.

### Points and Ranking

1. Points will be awarded as follows: 2 points for a win in regulation, 1 point for a tie, 0 for loss. Teams will be ranked in each pool by point totals at the end of the Round Robin. Rankings and Tie breakers for point totals for division play and division winner seeding as follows, in order:
  - a. Team with the most points
  - b. Highest scoring % i.e. goals have scored divided by the total goals scored, i.e. 3 games played won 2-0, loss 4-1, won 5-3. You scored 8 goals divided by 15 (total goals scored) = 0.5333. Highest percentage takes higher placing
  - c. Team with the most wins
  - d. Team with the fewest total penalty minutes
  - e. Most goals scored in round robin.

- f. The latest time of the first penalty is the higher seed
- g. If there is still a tie, it will be the earliest time of the first goal scored in tournament.

Overtime Format in Semi-Finals and Finals Games

1. Teams will play 2 on 2 (2 players plus 1 goalie) for a 5 minute overtime sudden victory period. Again, no time outs permitted in overtime.
2. If there are penalties, the team will play shorthanded (3 on 2) (an extra player will be added to the ice for the power play). Penalties will carry over from regulation time. When a penalty has been served, the teams will play 3 on 3 until the next stoppage of play, then will return to 2 on 2.
3. If still tied after the 5 minute overtime period, the game will be decided by a shootout.
4. Each team will designate 3 shooters (by placing a star beside their names on the game sheet) at the beginning of each medal round game. All 3 shooters from each team will have an opportunity to shoot. Teams will alternate shooting on the opposing goalie until all three shooters have shot. The team with the most goals will be declared the winner.
5. If the game is still tied after three shooters, new shooters will be picked and the shootout will continue as sudden victory. The first team to score without the corresponding shooter from the other team scoring will be declared the winner.
6. A player may not shoot twice in the shootout until every other player on the team has participated in the shootout.
7. The home team (team with highest rank) will be given the choice of shooting first or second at the start of the shootout.

Suspensions

1. Any player who receives a fighting misconduct or Match Penalty will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament.
2. Any suspensions incurred during the tournament will be served during the tournament. Any carry over will be served during the team's regular season games. Any suspension incurred while playing regular season, will be carried into the tournament as a game missed.
